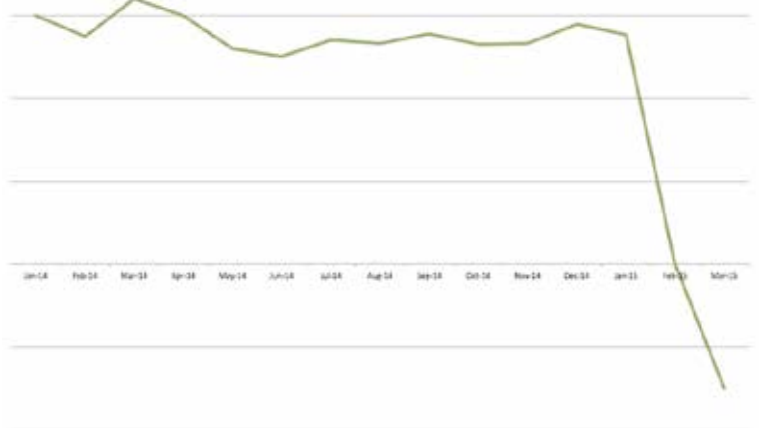

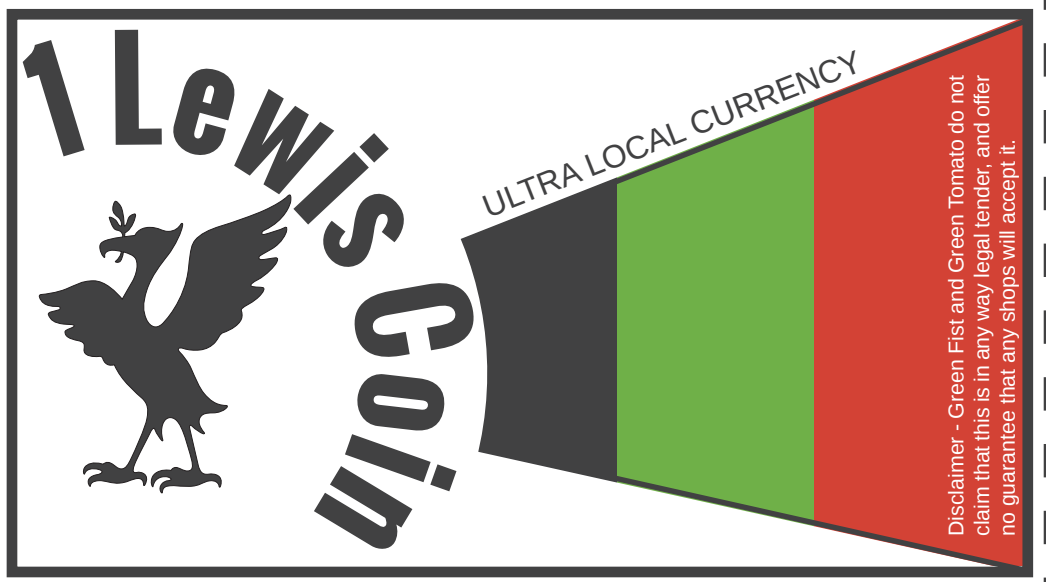

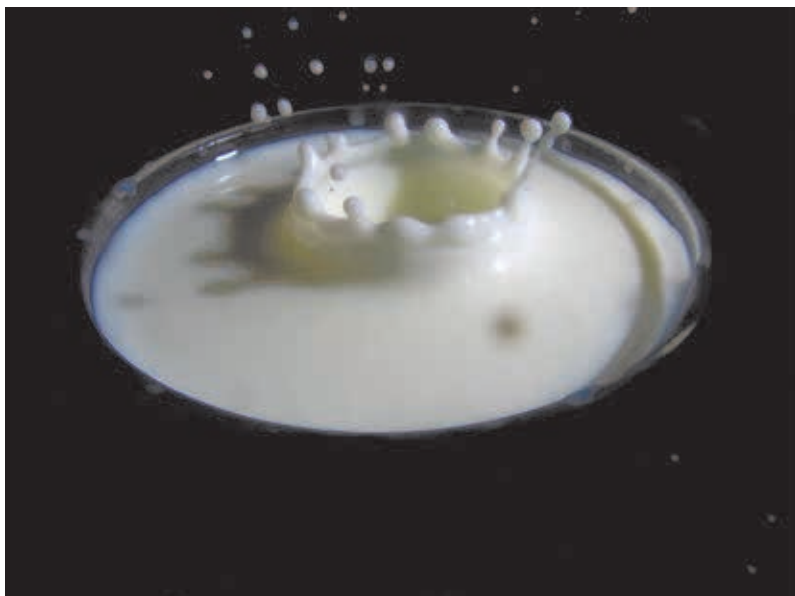

Autumn conference location "farcical"
